MIXED PAPER	All colors of office paper Cardstock Manila folders Envelopes Junk mail Staples/paper clips O.K.	No Ream/paper wrappers No Envelopes with metal clasps No paper cups, napkins or tissues No cereal box weight cardboard
NEWSPAPER MAGAZINE	Newspapers/Weathervane Magazines Glossy Brochures Phone Directories	No Ream/Paper Wrappers No Cereal box weight Cardboard No printer/copier paper
CARDBOARD Flatten, please	Corrugated cardboard Brown paper bags Ream/paper wrappers Cereal box weight Cardboard	No PIZZA BOXES No Wax-Coated boxes
GLASS/TIN/PLASTIC <u>Remove lids, rinse (and crush plastic and tin, specially MILK JUGS!)</u>	Washed tin cans (i.e. NO FOOD)  Usually water and pop bottles, 2 liters  Usually milk jugs All colors of glass	No yogurt containers or other #3,4,5, or 6 plastics containers. No containers with food remaining! PLEASE
PLASTIC BAGS	Empty, plastic grocery bags, bread bags, pallet wrap	No receipts, food contamination in plastic bags

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES (Place in plastic bag in nearest recycling area.)	Lead Acid, NiMH, NiCad, and Lithium- Ion batteries	Alkaline batteries
COMPUTER EQUIPMENT/ ELECTRONICS (Call x4546 for pick-up.)	All EMU purchased computer parts & peripherals, DVD & VCR players, TVs,	No Household computer equipment - take to Crutchfield, Goodwill, or Virginia Computer Recycling
TONER CARTRIDGES (Leave in nearest recycling collection area.)	Only EMU purchased toner or ink jet cartridges	No household cartridges – recycle at Staples
PACKING PEANUTS ONLY (Bag in a clean, sealed trash bag or labeled cardboard box, containing only peanuts & no other material/trash. Set in recycling area.)	Any color or shape of Styrofoam or cornstarch packing peanut	No Styrofoam blocks
