

Eastern Mennonite University (EMU) and Hesston College are eager to facilitate the transfer of students from Hesston to EMU as they pursue their educational goals.

Here are the main points of the transfer agreement established between Hesston College and Eastern Mennonite University:

1.) Hesston students completing an **Associate of Arts** or **Associate of Science** degree will satisfy EMU Core Curriculum requirements as follows:

- Complete one Bible/Religion course from a category designated “Christian Identity and Witness” (three credits.) Alternatively, this requirement may be met by taking either of two courses while at Hesston: Anabaptist History and Thought or Peacemaking and Justice.
- Complete the nine-credit cross-cultural requirement. All or part of this requirement may be completed by transferring appropriate courses from Hesston. Check with the EMU admissions counselor for details.
- Complete the final course in the EMU general education program: CORE 401 Senior Seminar (two credits.)

2.) Hesston grades are not calculated into the EMU grade point average. Grades of “D” will transfer for students who complete the AA or AS degree but are subject to the same limitations that apply to “D” grades earned at EMU. Similarly, grades of “C-” are not sufficient to satisfy requirements in some EMU majors. See the EMU Catalog for details.

3.) Students graduating with an **Associate in Applied Arts and Sciences** degree will have their courses evaluated on a course-by-course basis. Grades of “D” will not transfer. See the note above regarding grades of “C-”.

4.) A maximum of 65 credits from two-year colleges may transfer to EMU.
