**2005-06 HEAD-TO-HEAD:** Virginia Wesleyan has won both meetings against EMU this year as part of its current 20-game winning streak. In the fourth game of that streak, the teams met on December 7 in Harrisonburg. EMU led by 15 points with 12:20 remaining, but the Marlins, playing without leading scorer Brandon Adair, cut it to four with 8:13 remaining and finally tied the score with 3:16 left in the game. EMU led by three with 22 seconds remaining but junior Jason Lentz fouled Tyler Fantin on a three-point attempt and Fantin converted all three foul shots to tie the score and send the game into overtime. VWC went on to pull out the 78-75 overtime triumph. Terrell Dixon had 20 points to lead the Marlins. Thomas Sumpter had 13 points, four rebounds, five assists, and three steals. Norman Hassell had 12 points while Fantin finished with 10 and nine boards.

In the second meeting just four days ago, it was the Royals this time playing without their leading scorer, junior Jason Sager, who injured his thumb two games prior against Randolph-Macon. Despite his absence, EMU and 12th-ranked VWC were tied at 20-20 with 9:28 to go in the half. The Marlins closed the half on a 22-7 run to take a 15-point halftime lead. The run continued in the second half with the Marlins outscoring the Royals 18-4 to take a 29-point lead. Matt Towell led VWC with 15 points and five rebounds. Brandon Adair and Ton Ton Balenga had 13 points each while Marques Fitch added 12. Korey Whiting and Jason Lentz each had eight points and four rebounds for EMU.

**DEJAVU ALL OVER AGAIN?** The close to the 2005-06 season has an eerie feeling for the Royals as they find themselves in a similar position to a year ago. In 2004-05, EMU closed the regular season on a Tuesday in an 85-62 loss to Virginia Wesleyan at home. That placed EMU in a tie for 7th and the Royals won the tiebreaker to face #2 Virginia Wesleyan in the ODAC Quarterfinals. This year EMU finished the season on a Tuesday in an 84-51 loss at VWC to finish in a tie for seventh. This time EMU lost the tiebreaker and will face #1 Virginia Wesleyan in the ODAC Quarterfinals. In last year's match-up, VWC jumped out to a 27-10 lead only to see EMU get back in the game. The Royals trailed 45-44 with 16:34 remaining and were still in the game at 65-63 with five minutes to go. VWC scored the next six points though and went on to win 81-72. It was the closest final margin of victory for the Marlins as they went on to win the ODAC championship. Brandon Adair had 24 points, eight rebounds, and three blocks for the Marlins. Thomas Sumpter had 14 points, five rebounds, four assists, and three steals. Ton Ton Balenga had 14 points while Marques Fitch added 13. Korey Whiting had 23 points and 10 rebounds for EMU while Jason Sager also had a double-double with 19 points and 10 boards. Brad Parkes had 12 points and Jason Lentz added 10 points and nine rebounds.

**EMU IN THE ODAC TOURNAMENT:** The Royals are making their second straight appearance in the ODAC Tournament after a three-year absence prior to the 2004-05 season. EMU is 4-20 all-time in the tournament and has not won a game in post-season play since the 1982-83 team fell in the championship game to Randolph-Macon by a score of 77-70. That team was led by EMU all-time leading scorer Leonard Dow. The Royals are 0-15 in the tournament since that time with several close calls. This will be the third meeting in tournament play between EMU and VWC. In 1998, the sixth-seeded Marlins won 89-88 in overtime over the third-seeded Royals, which was also the last time EMU was seeded in the top four. The other meeting was last year's 81-72 win by #2 VWC over #7 EMU in the quarterfinals. This will be EMU's fifth appearance in the tournament as the #8 seed and the Royals are 0-4 in their previous appearances. In fact, only once in tournament history has the #8 seed knocked off the top seed. That was in 2004 when Lynchburg defeated Randolph-Macon 54-50.

**2005-2006 SEASON IN REVIEW:** In many ways, the 05-06 season was a season with a promising outlook, promising peak in the middle of the season, and a disappointing finish. EMU opened the season with an 87-84 win at Southern Virginia, a game in which the Royals trailed by as much as 15. The comeback against the Knights propelled the Royals to a 3-1 start in non-conference games before the ODAC season commenced. However, starting point guard Dustin Galyon was injured in the win over SVU. The Royals weathered his absence through the non-conference games, but they missed their floor general once ODAC play began. EMU found a tough go of it, falling by six at Roanoke, losing in overtime at home against Virginia Wesleyan after leading by as much as 15, and falling by five at Randolph-Macon. The lone highlight in the four-game stretch was a 64-52 win over nearby rival Bridgewater College that ended an 18-game losing streak against the Eagles. The Royals found themselves at 4-4 overall and 1-3 in the ODAC at the end of the fall semester. They split a pair of games over the winter break, defeating Ferrum and falling to Greensboro, before returning to ODAC play. Galyon, who had attempted a brief comeback against VWC, finally made his full return against Greensboro, returning to the starting line-up. In the first five ODAC games of 2006, EMU earned home victories over Lynchburg and Washington and Lee, but still found life on the road difficult, falling at Hampden-Sydney, Guilford, and Emory & Henry. After returning from the Guilford/Emory & Henry double-dip weekend, the Royals sat at 7-8 overall and 3-6 in the conference. A return engagement against Southern Virginia in the final non-conference game of the year sparked a turnaround. EMU defeated SVU and fell at Bridgewater before then taking three wins in a row over Roanoke, third-place Hampden-Sydney, and Lynchburg. The win over the Hornets was the first road conference victory of the season and improved EMU's record to 11-9 overall and 6-7 in the ODAC. EMU entered Super Bowl weekend in fifth place with a home doubleheader against Emory & Henry and Guilford and a chance to move into third place if other games went the right way. Instead, EMU had a one-point loss to the Wasps and a four-point loss to the Quakers that quickly deflated any momentum the Royals had built up. EMU went on to lose its home finale to Randolph-Macon 75-57 before then falling at Washington and Lee 91-68 and at Virginia Wesleyan 84-51. Instead of climbing into third, the Royals dropped into a tie for seventh and claimed the #8 seed in the tournament after losing the tie-breaker to Bridgewater. EMU lost its final three games by an average of 24.7 points. In addition, junior forward/guard Jason Sager, the team's leading scorer and the ODAC's leading rebounder, re-injured his oft-ailing shooting thumb during the Randolph-Macon game and was forced to sit out the final two games of the season. The Royals are hoping that he returns for EMU's quarterfinal match-up with Virginia Wesleyan and that they can turn things around in time to make a season-ending statement in the ODAC.

**HEAD COACH KIRBY DEAN:** In three short seasons, EMU's head man has already brought a winning attitude and tough work ethic to the Royals basketball program. In 2003, he took over a team that had gone 3-22 in the previous season and 1-17 in conference games. In his first season in 2003-04, the team's record improved to 6-19 overall and 4-14 in the ODAC. The Royals still finished in last place, but they won two of their final three games to carry some positive momentum into the 2004-05 campaign. In the preseason coaches poll in 2004, EMU was picked to finish tenth for a third straight season, but improvement continued in Harrisonburg. Under Dean's guidance, the Royals finished at 12-12 overall in the regular season and 8-10 in the ODAC. In just two years under Kirby Dean, EMU had improved from three wins overall and one in conference to 12 wins overall and eight in conference. While the Royals did not continue to build on the win total this year, they were picked to finish fifth in the ODAC, their highest preseason prediction ever, and were competitive with every team in the conference to finish the season at 11-14 overall and 6-12 in the ODAC. Dean, a 1992 graduate of EMU, played four years for the Royals before then working eight seasons as an assistant coach at Division I Virginia Military Institute. He spent one year as head coach at Waynesboro High School before taking the head coaching job at EMU in 2003.

**ODAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** EMU sophomore guard Korey Whiting earned ODAC Player of the Week honors on January 30. Whiting, a sophomore guard from Stafford, Va., led EMU in scoring in two ODAC victories for the week with solid all-around performances in both games. In an 86-79 win over Roanoke on Wednesday, he had a season-high 24 points with five rebounds, four assists, and three steals. He went 12-for-12 from the free-throw line to tie Joel Kauffman's ('01) EMU school record for free throw percentage in a game. Then on Saturday in an 80-73 triumph over Hampden-Sydney, he had 15 points, five rebounds, three assists, and five steals. For the week, Whiting averaged 19.5 points, five rebounds, 3.5 assists, and four steals while shooting 52.4% from the floor and 85% from the charity stripe.

**STATISTICAL LEADERS:** In the final regular season statistics, EMU had five players among the top 27 in the conference in leading scorers. No other school had more than three in that range. Jason Sager (17.3 ppg) was fourth, followed by Korey Whiting (14.2) in seventh, Jason Lentz (10.3) in 21st, Brad Parkes (10.0) in 25th, and E.J. Arrington (9.7) in 27th. Rebounding is a similar story with the Royals having four of the top 15. Randolph-Macon was the only school with as many as three. Sager (9.3 rpg) leads the ODAC, followed by Lentz (5.2) in 12th, Arrington (4.9) in 14th, and Whiting (4.9), in 15th. Also of note, Whiting is fourth in assists (3.24 apg), first in steals (2.68 spg), and fifth in assist to turnover ratio (1.05).

**THE 1,000 POINT CLUB:** Senior E.J. Arrington and junior Jason Sager each scored their 1,000th career points this year. Arrington reached the milestone in the first game of the year at Southern Virginia while Sager passed it on December 7 against Virginia Wesleyan at home. In addition, junior Jason Lentz (679), sophomore Korey Whiting (643), and sophomore Brad Parkes (611) are all in reasonable shape to reach 1,000 in their careers, meaning that this year's EMU squad could potentially be composed of five career 1,000-point scorers.
