

Financial Aid Checklist Graduate Education & Interdisciplinary programs

Steps to apply for financial aid (federal student loans)

- O Discuss tuition assistance options with your employer and search for outside grant and scholarship sources.
- O Complete the online EMU graduate student Financial Aid Information Sheet at <u>https://www.emu.edu/financial-aid/graduate-fais</u> Identify each source of outside assistance from employer, etc.
- O Complete 2024-25 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). File FAFSA at <u>https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa</u> EMU school code is 003708.

FAFSA is required if you are interested in borrowing a federal student loan.

O Receive and review your Financial Aid Notification emailed from EMU; sign electronically and complete all requested forms.

A financial aid notification is emailed after a student is admitted and submitted the FAIS and FAFSA.
