Additional information:

3. Classification Liquor Law Violations does not include arrests for Driving Under the Influence and Drunk In Public.
4. On Campus includes the figure from Residence Halls within the aggregate.
5. Non Campus includes property controlled by a recognized student organization or non-contiguous property (including Lancaster, WCSC) used by students in support or relation to the institutions purpose
6. Public Areas are mainly the city streets and sidewalks (both sides) bordering campus.
