MAGAZINES AND NEWSPAPERS	<p>Newspapers as well as magazines and other glossies may be recycled together. Phone directories, catalogs and other newsprint included Collect them in paper bags or boxes. Place containers in building recycling area.</p>

CANS AND BOTTLES	<p>Plastic #1s and #2s, only ***see numbers on bottom <i>POP BOTTLES & SIMILAR ARE USUALLY #1</i> <i>MILK JUGS & SIMILAR, #2</i> Glass, aluminum, tin</p>
