



Student Retention and Graduation Rates

The following information is provided to inform current and prospective students, parents and others of the retention and graduation rates of first-time, first-year undergraduate students at Eastern Mennonite University.

Presented below are the number and percentage of first-time, first-year students who returned for the second, third and fourth consecutive fall semesters following their initial enrollment. Four-, five-, and six-year graduation rates are also presented; students who graduated by August 31 of the indicated year are included.
