Definitions:

1. **At our school a "full-time student" is defined as one taking a minimum of GRADUATE courses: **9** credit hours per semester.**
2. **For calculating "full-time equivalent," the normal progress toward graduation is GRADUATE courses: **12** credit hours.**

Method A. Divide total student-hours or student-courses in the fall term by the normal progress toward graduation per term. For example, for the traditional 120 semester hours to be earned in eight semesters, the divisor would be 15.

Method B. Use the total number of full-time students and add the full-time equivalent of part-time students calculated as in Method A. (All of you have been reporting by Method B, and we use this method for making comparisons. Please report at least by Method B.)
