## GENERAL APPLICATION INFORMATION

**Martin House:** An intentional community consists of students sharing a “house living” experience. This opportunity provides an option for men and women to live together in a single-family dwelling owned by the University. Students must demonstrate the ability to live in a group situation prior to acceptance into this housing program. Martin is a house for undergraduate students focusing on community living.

**Application and Scoring:** Applications will be due **February 1, 2008**. To ensure that residents will be offered an equal opportunity to compete for placement in the house, each application will be scored by the selection committee on the point scale described below.

- 5 points – significant ability demonstrated to contribute to a group living situation
- 4 points – high potential demonstrated to live in a group living situation
- 2 points – no prior group living and very little campus or community participation
- 1 point – does not seem to understand the concept of group living
