Arun J. Sanyal, MD, is Professor of Medicine in the Division of Gastroenterology, Hepatology & Nutrition at Virginia Commonwealth University. He is also the Executive Director of Education Core for the Center for Clinical and Translational Research at VCU. He received his MBBS from Maulana Azad Medical College of Delhi University, India and MD from the All India Institute of Medical Sciences in New Delhi. Dr Sanyal completed his internal medicine residency at Texas Tech University, and a fellowship in gastroenterology and hepatology at VCU, where he has remained on the faculty as a professor and clinician. Over the past 10 years, much of his research has focused on clinical studies of nonalcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD), the role of the microbiome in NAFLD and nonalcoholic steatohepatitis (NASH), and the development of effective therapy for NASH. Dr Sanyal is past president and secretary of the American Association for the Study of Liver Diseases, and is active in numerous professional organizations. He currently serves as Chair of the steering committee for the NIH nonalcoholic steatohepatitis clinical research network.
